Ohio No-Till Council: County ag agents national meeting next month. Dave Brandt hosting field day July 14 and will discuss cover crops and wheat planting. Ohio No-Till Field Day, Sept 8, will include cover crops, no-till. Annual conference is Dec. 7, 2010.

No-Till on the Plains: Working on lots of grants. Finished field day June 30 in Sydney, Neb., where fallow is still used by many farmers. More field days planned. Bus Tour through southern Kansas and Oklahoma on July 27-29.

Pennsylvania No-Till Alliance: Hot and dry in Pennsylvania; some corn is done. PANTA struggling with funding issues. Membership contributions and grants fund the Alliance. RC&D grant is ending, so additional funds needed. Annual conference planned for February 2011. Organizing tour to visit Dwayne Beck in August. Extension is losing agronomy agents (one agronomist for half of state)

NRCS: new state agronomist in Texas doing work with strip-till and cover crops and making good progress
